How ISO Standards are Developed

An ISO standard is developed by a panel of experts within a technical committee. Once the need for a standard has been established, these experts meet to discuss and negotiate a draft standard. As soon as a draft has been developed it is shared with ISO members who are asked to comment and vote on it. If a consensus is reached, the draft becomes an ISO standard. If not, it goes back to the technical committee for further edits.

What is a Standard?

A standard is a document that provides requirements, specifications, or characteristics that can be used consistently to ensure that materials, products, processes and services are fit for their performance,

TS 16949

The ISO/TS16949 is an ISO technical specification aiming to the development of a quality management system that provides for continual improvement, emphasizing defect prevention and the reduction of variation and waste in the supply chain. It was developed for the automotive industry.

ISO 14001

ISO 14001 sets out the criteria for an environmental management system. It maps out a framework that a company or organization can follow to set up an effective environmental management system. It can be used by any organization that wants to improve resource efficiency, reduce waste and drive down costs.

The purpose of the training course is to prepare learners to plan and conduct internal audits of an ISO 14001 environmental management system within their organization..

Duration:

Training Overview:

The training is designed to provide learners with the knowledge and skills to successfully plan and prepare for an audit, perform an audit, document an audit, report the results of an audit, and manage corrective actions.

ISO Advanced Auditing & Evaluation:

Purpose:

To introduce learners to evaluate methods and techniques that may be employed to inform decision makers and the effectiveness, implementation and improvement of quality management systems and processes.

Duration:

Training Overview:

This course is intended for learners who have previously completed a course in internal auditing and have some experience performing audits. While auditing is about establishing conformity to requirements and agreed-upon criteria, evaluation is about making value judgments. Learners are introduced to the methods for establishing evaluative conclusions about effectiveness, value, worth, level of improvement, and how good an evaluation object is. The concept of evaluation—specific logic and methodology as described by Michael Scriven, Jane Davidson, and others, will be discussed and applied to quality management.
